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Did you Know? Accessibility in Canvas Promoting Successful Learning for All **Students**

Use the "Headings" feature in Microsoft Word for titles and subtitles of your documents so that headings and subheadings can be readily identified and not blend in with the text of the document. This makes it easier for interpretation and visualization of the layout of the

document for all, including students needing accommodations.
