SB17 in Teaching, Learning, and Student Interactions

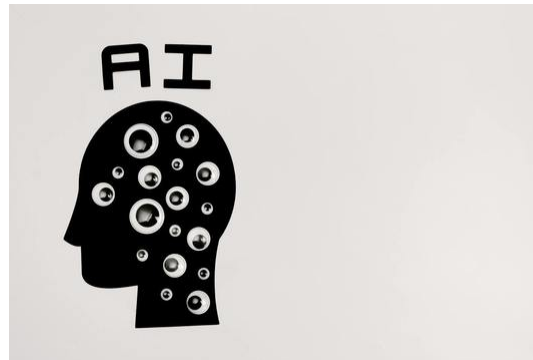
