## 2023-2024 UTA TASFA Checklist

The Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) is an application that determines whether undocumented/ DACA students are eligible for state or institutional financial aid. Students must be a Texas resident.

□ Complete a paper TASFA application to be considered for aid through UTA

- Include your and your parents' signatures on the application if dependent
- Send to the UTA Financial Aid Office

□ Include 2021 Tax Return Transcripts/1040 with your TASFA application

- Request your transcripts at www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript with the following information:
  - SSN or Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN)
  - Date of birth
  - Mailing address from your latest tax return
  - Estimated waiting times
    - Filed electronically: 5-10 days
    - · Filed by postal service: 5-6 weeks

□ Residency Affidavit certifies you are a Texas Resident for in-state tuition and for Texas grants.

• Send to the UTA Admissions Office
