2024-25 UTA TASFA Checklist

The 2024-25 Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) will be available December 2023 for SB1528/HB1403 students to apply for need-based state funds at <u>www.highered.texas.gov/our-work/empowering-our-students/tasfa/</u>. Funding is limited and applications are reviewed in the order received. Students must meet TEXAS Grant requirements (<u>www.uta.edu/administration/fao/grants/texas-grants</u>) and UTA deadlines.

Required documents must be received by April 1, 2024:

1. Send in a completed 2024-25 TASFA and include a copy of your 2022 Tax Return Transcripts, OR a copy of the Federal 1040 filed with the IRS and, if you're dependent, a copy of parent's tax returns.

- Include Schedules 1, 2, 3, if filed with the IRS.
- Request your transcripts at <u>www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript</u>.

2. Complete your UTA admission application and send all required documents for admission to the UTA Admissions Office.

• Transfer students must send college transcript with a conferred associate degree no later than June 15.

3. Send a Residency Affidavit that certifies you are a Texas resident to the UTA Admissions Office. Access the Residency Affidavit on our TASFA Applicants page (<u>www.uta.edu/administration/fao/apply-for-aid/tasfa-applicants</u>).

Financial Aid Offers Eligible TASFA applicants will receive an email notice to their UTA email address between mid-April and June 2024.
