



## 2022-2023 UTA TASFA Checklist

The Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) is an application that determines whether undocumented/DACA students are eligible for state or institutional financial aid. Students must be a Texas resident.

- Complete a paper TASFA application to be considered for aid through UTA
  - Include your and your parents' signatures on the application if dependent
  - Send to the UTA Financial Aid Office
- Include 2020 Tax Return Transcripts / 1040 with your TASFA application
  - Request your transcripts at [www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript](http://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript) with the following information:
    - SSN or Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN)
    - Date of birth
    - Mailing address from your latest tax return
    - Estimated waiting times
      - Filed electronically: 5-10 days
      - Filed by postal service: 5-6 weeks
- Residency Affidavit certifies you are a Texas Resident for in-state tuition and for Texas grants.
