2023-24 Blaze Forward Program

Undergraduate students who meet all eligibility requirements and deadlines will be offered a combination of grants and other gift aid* that will cover **100% of their tuition and mandatory fees for the fall 2023 and spring 2024 semesters**[†].

Program Eligibility Requirements

- All admission documents must be received by the UTA Office of Admissions by February 14, 2023.
- The FAFSA or TASFA application and any required verification documents must be received by the Office of Financial Aid by February 14, 2023.
- Transfer students (1) must have earned an Associate Degree (AD) within 12 months prior to the first date of enrollment, and (2) an updated transcript with the AD must be received by UTA Office of Admissions no later than June 15, 2023. All other program eligibility requirements must be met by February 14, 2023.
- Be a Texas resident charged the in-state tuition rate.
- Be eligible to receive awards through the Federal Pell Grant and the TEXAS Grant[‡] programs.
- Have a yearly family income of \$85,000 or less.
- Enroll as a full-time student at UTA (minimum of 12 undergraduate hours each long semester).

*May include federal, state, and institutional grants, as well as tuition waivers and general UTA scholarships.

[†]Average tuition and mandatory fees are \$12,200 for the fall 2022 and spring 2023 semesters. Average tuition and mandatory fees are subject to change for the fall 2023 and spring 2024.
