


- Select from list of clients and advocacy issues

#### Interventions

(Oakley et al. 2004, Smith et al. 2005, Cestone et al 2008):

- Practice teamwork exercise
- Smaller teams
- Time availability team formation
- Team ownership (naming and client selection)
- Team engagement agreements
- High level of instructor priming
- Peer-review weighted grading (citizenship and engagement)

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## This semester: POLS 3310 – Public Policy Analysis

- Form public policy consulting group
- Identify government client and problem
- Devise evidence-based policy solutions
- Evaluate solutions according to effectiveness, cost efficiency, and feasibility
- Make recommendation

### Findings

- Variation in engagement across teams persisted
- High levels of cohesion within some teams
- Limited effect of team agreement
- Best practices useful, but instructor monitoring critical
