


Building Student Teams

When building student production teams based on skills, leadership, and diversity, another key factor emerges: intrinsic motivation.



Should students choose their teams or is instructor choice the best? A blended model could be the answer, giving students ownership and control while ensuring a strong and diverse team.

- 1. Student Survey to determine skills/strengths.
- 2. Teams are built to include roles for a producer, cameraperson, and editor.
- 3. After building teams to ensure a variety of skill sets and strong leadership, students choose roles that do not always align with survey results.
- 4. Students ultimately select their roles based on work schedules, desire to learn more or less about a process, desire to work alone or with others, and project interest. Factors outside the classroom have a big impact on team building.
