

OER, Experiential Learning, and H5P in a Freshman History Course

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THE COURSE

- HIST 1332 Science and Technology in American Society II
- Majority of students are Engineering majors
- Key learning outcomes: ethics/civics of technology and science in historical context and the interrelationship between society and scientists, engineers, and technocrats
- Acquiring marketable skills is also a key outcome

THE OER "PROBLEM"

- History policy \$0 materials cost in core courses
- No existing choice for STS OER textbook
- Take OER used in traditional history survey and modify
- But students "don't read" anyway....
- Why not engage the students with creating content

The H5P Solution

- Student Teams suggested producing videos, textual analysis, images, and even one video game for learning!
- H5P Interactive Books solves many issues of accessibility and stability and will provide a uniform appearance
- Students can choose from all content types available for best presenting their materials
- I have full editorial control since teams will turn in the raw materials and I will build each book and embed in the Pressbooks OER

THE "R&D PROJECT"

- Based upon project management organization commonly utilized in the Aerospace
- Students assigned to a semester long team project including more in-depth undergraduate research
- Teams must create original interactive content
- Support from Experiential Learning librarians as needed

PROJECT PHASES

Concept Phase => Concept Plan
Research Phase => Development Plan
Development Phase => "First Flight"
Production Phase => Production Model
Final Report Phase

EXAMPLES

- MOON SHOT: 25-minute documentary utilizing NASA films, still pictures, and narrative analysis production of video done with support of the library
- <u>PSYCHOPHARMACOLOGY</u>: booklet of mid-century drug development with each page dedicated to a different pharmaceutical and its impact on society
- HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES: Hot spot pictures, videos, and image sliders to show changes in how society lived at mid-century
