Undergraduate Geography Students' Conceptions of Hunger: A Qualitative Case Study in Progress

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Research Questions

- 1. What are undergraduate geography students' conceptions of the phenomenon of hunger?
- 2. What are undergraduate geography students' experiences with planning, hosting, and presenting at an Oxfam Hunger Banquet on the UTA campus?
- 3. Which concepts from human geography do undergraduate geography students apply to their understanding of the phenomenon of hunger?
- 4. In what ways did the Oxfam Hunger Banquet shape geography students' conceptions of hunger?

Qualitative Data Sources

Illustrations

At the beginning and at the end of the semester, students are given a blank sheet of paper and asked to "draw an illustration of hunger"

Reflection Essays

- What? What have you learned about hunger since your last reflection?
- Gut? Describe how this
 assignment has influenced your
 emotions, attitudes, and/or
 values?
- So What? How has your understanding of hunger changed since the beginning of the semester? How has this assignment influenced your knowledge, skills, values, and/or actions?
- Now What? What are your next steps?


End-of Semester Interviews

Class Assignment

Draw an illustration of Hunger

Read the Oxfam Hunger Banquet planning toolkit



Select one of the targets of the UN SDG- Zero Hunger.

Find recent news stories related to the UN SDG target.

- Now what? What do you think you will do with the knowledge you have gained? How might you apply it to you life and learning? How might it influence your actions and values?

Create an informative and persuasive two-minute Powtoon video in which you present and illustrate key facts, data, and images that capture the key concerns associated with the target and indicators you selected to study.





Spring 2022 Status
