Students must turn in all documents required by UTA Admissions before the March 1 deadline to be considered for UTA's merit-based scholarships. By meeting this requirement, all new, incoming students are automatically considered for these scholarships. No additional application is needed.

Financial Aid Priority Deadline March 1, 2025

Help ensure your students qualify for maximum funding at UTA for the fall 2025, summer 2025, or spring 2026 terms. Students must complete the following steps before the priority deadline:

1. Apply and be admitted to UTA by March 1, 2025 Complete the 2025-26 FAFSA, TAFSA and submit all required documents by March 1, 2025

These deadlines also apply for consideration of the

Blaze Forward Program. The Blaze Forward Program utilizes a combination of grants, scholarships, and tuition waivers to fully cover tuition and course fees for eligible students. However, additional expenses such as housing, meals, or textbooks are not covered by either the Blaze Forward Program or Financial Aid. Application Priority Dates

The <u>UTA application priority dates</u> for the 2025-26

academic year are as follows:

 Fall Term: February 15 Spring Term: October 15

Summer Term: April 1 Applications are accepted after these priority dates; however, submitting an application and required

documents by these deadlines ensures full consideration for the intended start term. Students applying to the College of Architecture, Planning, and Public Affairs (CAPPA) must submit a

completed application by February 15, 2025.
