All students majoring in Architecture are admitted initially into our Basic Studies program. Student's complete 1st and 2nd year ARCH courses in a prescribed sequence before declaring a major and enrolling in any 3000/4000 level ARCH/INTD courses. The strictly enforced sequential Undergraduate Architecture major programs will take a minimum of 8 semesters (4 years) to complete for both new freshman and transfer students.
