- \* The TCCNS course ENGR 1201 Introduction to Engineering will be accepted in transfer by substitution for UTA's ENGR 1101 Entrance to Engineering for Transfer Students.
- \* TCCNS MATH 2318 and MATH 2320 or MATH 2421 will be accepted in transfer by substitution for UTA's MATH 3319
- \* TCCNS ENGR 2301 Engineering Mechanics – Statics will be accepted in transfer by substitution for UTA's CE 2311 Statics
- \* TCCNS ENGR 2302 Engineering Mechanics – Dynamics will be accepted in transfer by substitution for UTA's CE 2221 Dynamics
- \* The TCCNS course ENGR 2332 Mechanics of Materials will be accepted in transfer by substitution for UTA's ENGR 2313
- \* TCCNS ENGR 2308 Engineering Economics will be accepted in transfer by substitution for UTA's IE 2308 Economics for Engineers
- \* TCCNS ENGR 1304 Engineering Graphics will be accepted in transfer by substitution for UTA's CE 1353. But transfer students must take CE 2153
- \* TCCNS ENGR 1307 Plane Surveying will be accepted in transfer by substitution for UTA's CE 2331 Engineering Measurement and Computer modeling.
