#### **RESINOUS MATIRX TERRAZZO FLOORING**

#### PART 1 – GENERAL

#### 1.1 PURPOSE

A. This guideline is intended to provide useful information to the Professional Service Provider (PSP) to establish a basis of design. PSP is to apply the principles of this section such that the University of Texas at Arlington (UTA) may achieve a level of quality and consistency in the design and construction of their facilities. Deviations from these guidelines must be approved by UTA and may require justification through Life Cycle Cost (LCC) analysis and submitted to UTA for approval.

#### 1.2 LESSONS LEARNED AND DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

- A. Refer to PART 3 EXECUTION, 3.4 CLEANING for specific UTA sealing process.
- **B.** Refer to Owner's Control Samples for actual UTA colors and Part 4 Appendix for color representations.

#### 1.3 SECTION INCLUDES

- A. Epoxy matrix terrazzo with ground/polished finish.
- B. Pre-cast stair treads.

#### 1.4 RELATED REQUIREMENTS

A. Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) Content Restrictions section in Division 01.

#### 1.5 REFERENCE STANDARDS

- A. NTMA (GRAD) Aggregate Gradation Standards; The National Terrazzo and Mosaic Association, Inc; current edition.
- B. NTMA (EPOXY) Epoxy Terrazzo Specifications; The National Terrazzo and Mosaic Association, Inc; Current Edition located at www.ntma.com.

#### 1.6 SUBMITTALS

- A. See Division 01 for submittal procedures.
- B. Product Data: Provide data for sealer and anchors; include printed copy of current NTMA recommendations for type of terrazzo involved.
- C. Shop Drawings: Submit plan, section, elevation, anchors and perspective drawings as necessary to determine the required dimensions and placement location for each product specified as well as clarify the manufacturer's recommended installation, joinery and termination techniques.
- D. Samples: Submit two samples, 12 inch by 12 inch in size illustrating color, chip size and variation, chip gradation, matrix color, and typical divider strip.
- E. Cleaning and Maintenance Data: Include procedures for stain removal, stripping, and sealing.

#### 1.7 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Perform work in accordance with NTMA recommendations as posted at their web site at www.ntma.com.
- B. Installer Qualifications: Company specializing in performing the type of work specified in this section.
  1. Minimum ten years of documented experience.

#### 1.8 DELIVERY, STORAGE, AND HANDLING

- A. Transport, store and handle precast concrete stair treads in accordance with manufacturers written instructions.
- B. Store precast terrazzo stair treads on pallets clear of mud and water. Stack precast terrazzo concrete stair treads to allow air to circulate freely and keep treads dry.
- C. Do not allow cast in anchor bolts to be damaged during handling or to rust during storage.
- D. Transport and store stair treads so that edges and corners of treads are not damaged.

#### EPOXY MATRIX TERRAZZO APPLICATIONS 2.1

- A. Stair Treads and Landings:
  - 1. Tread Dimensions: Refer to Drawings.
  - Tread Profile/Edge: Refer to Drawings. 2.
  - 3. Color: See Owner's control sample.
  - 4. Finish: See Owner's control sample.
  - 5. Aggregate Type and Size: See Owner's control sample.

#### 2.2 MATERIALS

- A. Epoxy Matrix Terrazzo Topping: Aggregate and matrix mix applied to substrate, leveled, and ground smooth. 1). Mix Proportions: As required to achieve appearance specified.
- B. Epoxy Matrix: Two component resin and epoxy hardener with mineral filler and color pigment, non-volatile, thermo-setting.
- C. Aggregate: Type as indicated; sized in accordance with NTMA Aggregate Gradation Standards; color(s) as indicated, uniform in color.
- D. Finishing Grout: Epoxy, color to match terrazzo matrix.
- E. Reinforcing Bars: ASTM A615, Grade 40, #3 3/8 inch deformed rebar.
- F. Embedded Stair Tread Anchor Bolts: ÅSTM F 1554, Grade 36.
  - Hot-dip or mechanically deposited, zinc-coated anchor bolts with nuts for attaching and securing stair 1. treads to stair framing.
  - Shoulder Nut: Manufacturer's anchor bolt design to resist damage due to excessive torque stress on 2. anchor bolt nut, or normal stair movement.

#### PART 3 - EXECUTION

- 3.1 PREPARATION
  - A. Clean substrate of foreign matter.
  - B. Apply primer in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

#### 3.2 **INSTALLATION**

A. Cutting, Fitting, and Installation: Perform cutting, drilling, and fitting required for installing precast concrete stair treads. Set units accurately in location, alignment, and elevation, measured from established lines and levels.

#### 3.3 TOLERANCES

- A. Maximum Variation from Flat Surface: 1/8 inch in 10 feet.
- B. Maximum Variation from Level: 1/8 inch.

#### 3.4 CLEANING

- A. Scrub and clean terrazzo surfaces with cleaner.
  - 1. Mask all material adjacent to terrazzo with protective covering where necessary.
  - 2. Remove all existing floor finish with low odor stripper.
  - 3. Rinse, vacuum/squeegee.
  - 4. Make six (6) passes with 3M<sup>TM</sup> Trizact<sup>TM</sup> Red Diamond HX Discs.
  - Clean-up slurry created during Red Disc Phase with a wet vac. 5.
  - 6. Make six (6) passes with 3M<sup>TM</sup> Trizact<sup>TM</sup> Blue Diamond HX Discs.
  - 7. Clean-up slurry created during Blue Disc Phase with a wet vac.
  - 8. Clean the floor with an auto-scrubber, a clean Red Buffer Pad 5100, and 3M Neutral Cleaner until no residue remains on the floor.
  - 9. Rinse, vacuum/squeegee, and let dry.
- B. Seal and polish surfaces
  - 1. Using a high speed (1500 rpm or higher) burnisher, make four (4) to six (6) passes using the 3M Scotch-Brite Purple Diamond Pad.
  - 2. Dust the area using the 3M Easy Trap Duster.
  - 3. Apply a thin, uniform coat of Scotchgard Stone Floor Protector with Wet Easy Shine Applicator Pad.
  - Allow at least fifteen (15) minutes to dry. 4.
- Burnish with the Scotch-Brite Purple Diamond Floor Pad Plus. Make two (2) passes. UTA - Section 09 66 23

- 6. Apply a second, uniform coat of Scotchgard Stone Floor Protector with Wet Easy Shine Applicator Pad.
- 7. Allow at least fifteen (15) minutes to dry.
- 8. Burnish with the Scotch-Brite Purple Diamond Floor Pad Plus. Make two (2) passes.
- 9. Dust the area using the 3M Easy Trap Duster.
- C. Upon completion of work, clean all debris accumulated during refinishing process.




- A. Protect finished terrazzo from damage due to subsequent construction until Date of Substantial Completion.


