

- Get ideas


#### Later years: increasing depth

- Identification of expertise/ niche

# Public Administration and Public Policy (PAPP)

- Uniqueness Interdisciplinary
  - 8 required courses
  - 4 research courses
  - 1 elective
  - Total coursework: 39 hours
  - Min for degree: 48 hours
- FT student: 2 years to complete coursework
- End of coursework (39 hours), take comprehensive exam
- Proposal
- Dissertation (up to 66 hours)

- Coursework: 39 credit hours
  - Leveling courses: 6 hours
  - Core: 9 hours
  - Methods courses: 12 hours
  - Electives/ Field area courses:12 hours
- Full-time student: 2 years to complete coursework
- End of coursework (39 hours), present preproposal
- Field exam & Proposal
- Dissertation (up to 66 hours)

1	Assigned a Faculty Adviser	Faculty Adviser	Grad Adviser	Upon Admission
2	Milestone Agreement form & select 1st semester courses	Faculty Adviser	Grad Adviser	Prior to or early in first semester
3	Form Diagnostic Advisory Committee (DAC)	Faculty Adviser	Grad Adviser	End of 1 <sup>st</sup> year of Ph.D.
4	Schedule diagnostic evaluation	DAC	Grad Adviser	On or right after 18 hours of study
5	Set up Dissertation Committee	Dissertation Committee	Grad Adviser	Prior to starting dissertation work
6	Take Comprehensive/ Field exam	DAC/ Dissertation Committee	Grad Adviser	Upon completion of coursework
7	Take dissertation hours	Dissertation Chair	Grad Adviser	After initiating dissertation
8	Defend proposal & achieve candidacy/ ABD status	Dissertation Committee	Grad Adviser	Dissertation work
9	Defend dissertation	Dissertation Committee	Grad Adviser	Last semester
