Admission Requirements

- Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 based on the last 60 hours of course work. Many applicants with below a 3.0 GPA are still admitted under a one-semester probation
- Letters of Recommendation (3 required)
- Essay of approximately 250 words: Describe why you want to earn a master's degree and what relevant background and experience you bring to the program.
- Complete online application and application fee
- GRE. Usually waived based on applicant work experience and undergraduate GPA and CoVID19 policies.
- Submit official, sealed transcripts.
