The minor in Commercial Film Production prepares an art or non-art major with an excellent foundation in commercial film production. This includes gaining technical skills in digital video production, concept development, and the application of the aesthetic abilities needed by students who want to work in commercial film industry. This minor pairs well with other disciplines requiring video production for entertainment, promotion, and training. After completing four required courses, students can choose from a range of upper level classes depending on individual goals.

The student's major department must approve any minor. However, students interested in Commercial Film Production as a minor should consult an Art Department/Faculty advisor to determine the most advantageous selection of courses. A Commercial Film Production Minor requires at least 18 credit hours in our program, including credit hours of advanced work.
