



Minor In Art- Art History

The student's major department must approve any minor. However, students interested in Art History as a minor should consult an Art Department/Faculty advisor to determine the most advantageous selection of courses. An Art History Minor requires at least 18 credit hours in a given program, including nine credit hours of advanced work.
