

Minor In GENERAL ART

The minor in General Art coursework gives students opportunities to experience various studio arts. Our program is fine art based, and the tools that are learned are applicable to a range of practices. After completing three required courses, students can choose from a range of intermediate/upper level classes, depending on individual goals.

The student's major department must approve any minor. However, students interested in a General Art minor should consult an Art and Art History Department advisor/faculty advisor to determine the most advantageous selection of courses. A General Art Minor requires at least 18 credit hours, including at least 6 credit hours of advanced work.
