

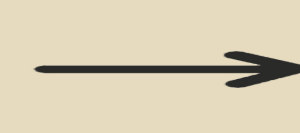

READING COMPREHENSION



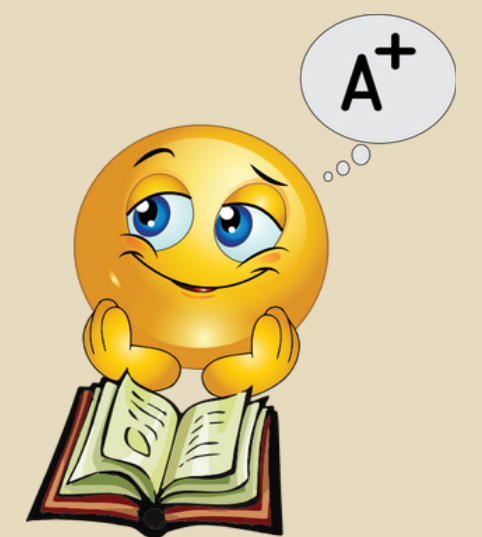
- Still lost after reading that primary document FIVE times?!
