## Phase 1: Coursework and Requirements in Senior Year

- I have met with the Graduate Advisor to review which courses at the 5000 level I should take.

- I have met all other requirements for completing my B.A. in French.

## Phase 2: Full-time Graduate Student in Modern Languages

- I have secured a copy of the Master of Arts Reading List in my language of specialization and begun tracking what works I have studied and which are still pending.
- Completed MODL Electives (French: 6-9 hours)

- Take MODL 5301 (Spanish)
- Take Translation Exam
- Test out of 2314 in another language through the CLEP test.
