INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS ACCEPTED INTO THE B.A./M.A. IN MODERN LANGUAGES

Phase 1: Coursework and Requirements in Senior Year

- I have met with the Graduate Advisor to review which courses at the 5000 level I should take.
- I have taken three 5000-level courses with a grade of B or better. I have selected these courses in consultation with the Graduate Advisor.
- I have met all other requirements for completing my B.A. in Spanish for Global Competence.

Phase 2: Full-time Graduate Student in Modern Languages

- I have met with the Graduate Advisor to review course offerings in upcoming semesters.
- I have secured a copy of the Master of Arts Reading List in my language of specialization and begun tracking what works I have studied and which are still pending.
- Completed MODL Electives (Spanish: 6-9 hours)
- Completed FREN 5XXX (Spanish: 30-33 hours)

Please note: You should be mindful about taking both literature and linguistics courses, when applicable. Failure to properly plan your coursework will result in problems preparing for or passing your Master's Examination.

Language Requirement, only one of the following:

- Take (or have taken) four semesters of college-level language courses in the same language, other than Spanish
- Take MODL 5301 (French)
- Take Translation Exam
- Test out of 2314 in another language through the CLEP test.

Please note: A student is not permitted to be tested in their native language for this requirement.

Administrative Requirements in your second to last semester in the M.A. program, all apply:

- Fill out Degree Plan Worksheet
- Submit it to the Graduate Advisor
- Consult with the M.A. Exam Committee about your Reading List

Administrative Requirements in your last semester, all apply:

- Remember that you must have been enrolled in the previous semester
- Apply for Graduation (see Graduate Academic Calendar for due date).
- Request an exemption if you are a GTA and taking less than 9 hours of course work.
- Fill out Final Master's Exam Report upon completion of the exam.
- File Master's Exam Report with the Graduate School.
