Students wishing to pursue a Fall Student Teaching placement should be aware that this will require some semesters to have a heavy course load. Students are considered a full-time student when enrolled in Clinical Teaching (check with Financial Aid to see how much is covered at least one semester before clinical/student teaching)

MUSI 2300 is strongly recommended for Creative Arts Core as it contains content for the TExES Music exam (Teacher certification exam).

MUSI 3394 is recommended to Fulfill Computer Competency requirement; see catalog for other options and information regarding computer competency exam.

A Senior Recital is required during the last semester of required lessons.

Enrollment in a Concert Band is required every semester as a Large Ensemble credit all semester students are enrolled in Private lessons and/or 6 or more Credit Hours.

For observations to count toward the required Texas Education Agency (TEA) observations, students will be admitted into the Education Preparation Program (EPP) during MUSI 3316. See Dr. Lange for admittance information. For EDUC 3301 Diverse Populations, students need to have 20-hours of observations in public school classrooms for this class. Students need to understand this requirement because if they have a heavy semester before clinical (student) teaching, they need to take Diverse Populations during clinical teaching.

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
