Hello everyone and Happy New Year! Please read this document carefully regarding auditions for the UTASO for the spring and instructions for the first concert cycle.

- WW/Brass/Percussion students-there are only openings in the following sections for the spring: French Horn, Tenor Trombone, and Percussion. Please prepare 1 standard orchestral excerpt and 1 solo of your choice for the audition. I will also ask you for 2 scales of my choice. Please note the violins are in no particular order, and the exact seating will be determined later by auditions. Besides our two concerto competition winners, we will feature Schumann's Fourth Symphony (revised version-1851) on our first concert. All students can download parts on IMSLP according to the assignments (or your instrument for viola, cello and bass) below. (Bowed string parts will be uploaded to Canvas next week, and I'll announce when those are ready. You can begin practicing from the blank parts at IMSLP, though.)
