Marching Band Camp 2023 Information Guide for Parents

The camp office is located in Room 104 of the Fine Arts Building. Camp staff are on duty in this room from 8:30am to 5:30pm for the assistance of campers.

Camp rules are strictly enforced at all times. Parents will be notified immediately of any severe rules infractions. The UTA Band Camps reserve the right to dismiss students from camp (with parent notification) those who do not follow camp rules. No refund is made for students dismissed for rules violations.

Attendance at rehearsals and the performance is mandatory of all participants. Any absence must be cleared in advance by notifying the camp director and instructors in charge. Any student leaving camp must sign in and out through the camp office.

Commuter students being dropped off for camp should be brought to the Fine Arts Building only and must_arrive in time for the first instructional session listed on their schedule. Please note that commuting students may not arrive prior to 8am.

The camp instructional day ends at 5:30pm. Any commuter student not picked up by parents by 6:00 pm will be escorted by counselors to West Hall (our camp dormitory) where they may be picked up.

Commuters staying for evening activities may be picked up by parents at the conclusion of the event at the West Hall Dorm only! Evening activities on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday conclude at 9:30pm.

Commuters are not permitted in the room areas of the residence halls at any time. If a commuter wishes to stay on campus to wait for the evening activity, they are permitted only in the common areas of West Hall or The Commons Dining Hall only. No students may remain in the Fine Arts Building after 5:30pm.

Dorm Checkout on Thursday

Students will clean up, pack and check out of their individual rooms from 4-6pm on Thursday. Students will have the option of storing their luggage in West Hall until the conclusion of the exhibition performance or moving their belongings to their cars if parents are on campus before 6pm. Students are encouraged to stay for the entire exhibition performance. Students are required to clean their own room and to have their room examined by camp staff before they will be permitted to check out. Students checking out without staff verification will be billed for room cleaning (\$75). Lost keys/access cards incur a charge of \$95 and must be paid before checkout.
