This interdisciplinary course offers a comprehensive, intensive, visual, multimedia overview of all of medicine. It covers the basic, preclinical, and clinical sciences, emphasizing the main principles and logic of medicine, how doctors think, and how the healthcare system works. Specific topics covered include an Introduction to Medicine, Embryology & Principles of Anatomy, General & Systems Physiology, Molecular Biology & Biochemistry, Neuroscience, Microbiology & Immunology, Pathology, Pharmacology, Epidemiology & Public Health, Internal Medicine specialties (Cardiology, Pulmonology, Nephrology, Gastroenterology, Infectious Diseases, Endocrinology, Rheumatology, Hematology / Oncology), Neurology, Pediatrics, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Surgery, Anesthesiology, Surgical Subspecialties (Cardiovascular Surgery, Orthopedic Surgery, Ophthalmology, Otorhinolaryngology, Dermatology, Urology, Neurosurgery), Psychiatry, Radiology and Radiation Oncology. Importantly, it spans both the **scientific and humanistic aspects** of medicine, referencing the visual arts, music, film, and other forms of art to highlight key points. Though primarily designed for students aiming for a career in the health professions, it should appeal to anyone curious about health and medicine works.
