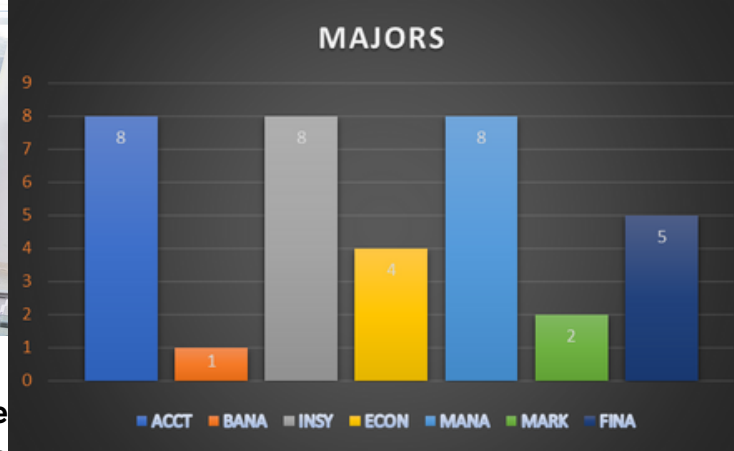

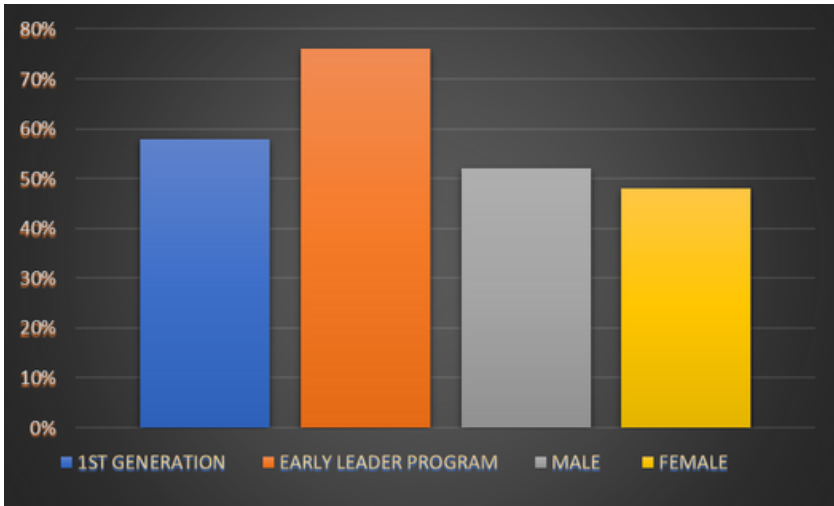
WELCOME COHORT 20!
