

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Master of Science in Real Estate program is designed to provide students an opportunity to obtain a better understanding of the mechanics of real estate decisionmaking in modern society and a greater depth of training in the discipline of real estate decision-making than is possible at the baccalaureate level. Offered Saturdays in Fort Worth, the MS in Real Estate program is a 36-credit hour degree designed to prepare students for commercial real estate careers through lessons in development, finance, investment, brokerage, management, valuation, and consulting. Program content also includes training for public sector real estate careers, including urban planning, tax assessment, and community development.
