About the Program

The objective of doctoral studies in Operations and Supply Chain Management is to develop scholars with an ability to teach and conduct independent research. This is accomplished through a combination of coursework and research activities. The coursework provides fundamental knowledge in various areas of management science and operations management. Students work closely with faculty members on research projects that have wide ranging implications for the industry and the economy. Students also receive training in teaching methods and get an opportunity to teach undergraduate classes. It takes about four years to complete the program. Our graduates have been hired by comprehensive research universities such as University of Texas at Tyler, University of North Texas, State University of New York at Oneonta, University of New South Wales and others.
