STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM IN FRANKFURT AND PARIS

Answers to most commonly asked questions about College of Business's **NEW Study Abroad Program in Frankfurt and Paris.**

When will the program be offered?

The course will be offered as part of UT Arlington's Spring semester. Typically, the class is scheduled to begin in mid-January for 5 days of total classes on campus. Then, we fly to Frankfurt in the week of May 17 where we will study for one week and move to Paris for another week before returning to DFW in late May. Specific dates and times are usually published during the Fall semester preceding the trip.

Where will the classes be held?

The first five classes will be offered on UTA campus. The rest of the classes will be taught in Frankfurt, Germany and Paris, France.

How much will it cost?

The cost is approximately \$1900.

What does the above price include? What is not included?

The price includes hotel (in Frankfurt) and home stay (in Paris), orientation, local transportation, English-speaking on-site support, forum with local students, required field trips to businesses, intercultural communication training, a welcome lunch/dinner, and a farewell dinner. It **does not include** UTA tuition, airfare, or personal expenses for food and entertainment. The airfare is expected to be around \$1500.

Will there be any problems in transferring credit?

These are UTA classes taught by UTA faculty to UTA students at an off campus location. Therefore, there will be no issues of transfer of credits.

What courses are offered?

ECON 3303 Money and Banking

ECON 4331 Studies in Economics (for those who took ECON 3303 already)

Each is a *three credit hour class and you are allowed to choose one of them, not both.*

Can I get financial aid or scholarship for this program?
