To register for commencement:

1) Visit Marching Order to create your account. Under **New Users** click **Register** and insert your student email address.

2) Log in and complete your profile.

3) You may return to the site anytime by going to the <u>Login Page</u> and using your student email email address.

Ordering Your Cap, Gown, and Other Memorabilia

Orders for caps, gowns, and tassels must be placed by July 19 to guarantee their arrival in time for commencement. Orders can be placed in person or online at the <u>UTA Bookstore</u>, located at 400 Spaniolo Drive. Before placing your order, make sure you include the correct tassel color

Commencement Tickets

In-person graduates will receive GradPasses via email the week of commencement. The GradPass will be your ticket for entry to your ceremony and will be needed as you cross the stage. GradPasses will need to be printed and presented at entry on your commencement day.

All in-person guests over the age of 2 must have a ticket to attend the ceremony. There will be three separate opportunities to claim tickets for your guests.

On July 20, you should receive an email to your uta.edu email address with information on how to claim your graduate and guest tickets for Ticket Offer 1. All unclaimed tickets will be returned to the ticket pool for Ticket Offers 2 and 3. More information on the process can be found on the <u>Guest Ticket</u> page.

If you do not receive the email, you can still claim your reserved tickets at <u>utatickets.com</u>.

Diplomas

Your diploma will be mailed to your mailing address listed in your graduation application six to eight weeks after your degree has been conferred.

Commencement Program

All graduates participating in summer 2021 in-person or virtual ceremonies will receive a commemorative program. If you have opted in MyMav to restrict directory information, your name will not appear in the printed or digital program. To prevent this, make sure you have no FERPA holds on your directory information in MyMav by July 1.
