### Commencement schedule

Ceremonies will be held Friday, May 12, at Globe Life Field in Arlington. A <u>detailed schedule</u> is below, and the university announcement about our return to Globe Life can be found here.

- 9:00am College of Nursing and Health Innovation and School of Social Work
- 2:00pm College of Liberal Arts, College of Engineering and Honors College (Interdisciplinary Studies)
- 7:00pm College of Architecture, Planning and Public Affairs, College of Business, College of Science, Division of Student Success (University Studies) and College of Education

Please be mindful that UTA encourages all graduates to arrive at Globe Life Field 60-90 minutes before their ceremony to allow adequate time to park and check into the graduate area. Additional guidance for arriving at Globe Life Field will be posted on the website and emailed closer to commencement.

If you indicated in MyMav your preference for participating in commencement virtually or selected virtual website commencement inside MarchingOrder, additional details for that experience will be distributed after May 15.

# Create your commencement profile by April 14

UTA uses MarchingOrder to allow graduates to register, request guest tickets and create their graduate profile. Follow this link, then select "Register Here" and complete the profile questions to gain access to receive guest tickets, let us know your name's pronunciation, request ADA accommodations, and submit a photo for your graduate slide. Photos will be used during the ceremony at Globe Life as well as the website. Please complete your profile in MarchingOrder by April 14.

## Order your regalia and other memorabilia

<u>UTA Bookstore</u> is the official retailer of UTA caps and gowns and you can order online or in store. We recommend candidates purchase regalia early to ensure proper sizing, though the bookstore will have most items available all the way up to commencement. Before placing your order, make sure you include the <u>correct tassel color</u> and/or hood for your school or college.

<u>Grad Finale is scheduled for March 6-9.</u> During Grad Finale, the Bookstore will offer the best prices (online and in-store), exclusive bundle packages, and the last chance to order rings to arrive for the Ring Ceremony, and so much more!

#### **Guest tickets**

For graduates attending in-person ceremonies, you may reserve tickets for your guests within your <u>MarchingOrder</u> profile. You can adjust the number of tickets you need at any time until **April 14**. Tickets will be delivered electronically after May 1.

Graduates do not need a ticket to enter. You will be sent a GradPass through MarchingOrder after May 8.
