Courses

NURS 5327

Exploration of Science and Theories for Nursing

This course provides a critical examination of the philosophical and theoretical bases for nursing science.

Five Week Course | Prerequisite: Graduate Standing | 3 Credit Hours

NURS 5366

Principles of Nursing Research

This course focuses on integration of theoretical and empirical principles of nursing research to generate evidence for nursing practice.

Five Week Course | Prerequisite: Graduate Standing | 3 Credit Hours

NURS 5367

Evidence Based Practice

Preparation to lead evidence-based practice teams, to interpret best evidence, to plan for change, to evaluate outcomes, and to disseminate the project.

NURS 5308

Nursing Informatics

Focus on application of computer technology that supports the dissemination of health care data, information and knowledge. Selected software packages/applications are presented and used.

NURS 5311

Nursing Management in the Health Care Environment

Considers development of management and organizational theories as applied to health care organizations and their environment.

NURS 5343

Nursing Leadership and Complex Health Care Systems

Analyze leadership strategies in current and predicted health care systems including dimensions of workforce and workplace issues, leadership, and evidenced-based decision-making.

NURS 5341

Financial Management in Nursing

Analyze and apply financial management concepts to financial planning, budgeting, and reimbursement systems in health care.

Five Week Course | Prerequisites: NURS 5311 | 3 Credit Hours

NURS 5342

Management of Nursing Operations

Examine strategic planning for health care systems.

Five Week Course | Prerequisite: NURS 5311 | 3 Credit Hours

NURS 5388

Statistics for Health Care

This course provides students with the basic knowledge and skills to effectively use biostatistics in different research design and data analysis, and to understand articles in related professional journals. Topics include choosing correct statistical methods and study designs in nursing research and practice; descriptive statistics; probability and probability distributions; estimation and hypothesis testing, simple linear regression, introduction to analysis of variance and an introduction to the use of statistical software packages.

NURS 5339

Roles and Functions of the Nurse Administrator

Examine and implement administrative and managerial roles in health care organizations.

Five Week Course | Prerequisite: NURS 5311 | 3 Credit Hours

NURS 5382

Nursing and Health Care Policy: Issues and Analysis

Analyze historical, current, and predicted national, state, and local health care policy processes.

Five Week Course | Prerequisites: NURS 5367 | 3 Credit Hours

NURS 5340

Management Seminar and Practice

Synthesize management, organizational, and leadership concepts and theories in selected health care settings.

Ten Week Course | Prerequisite: NURS 5308, 5311, 5339, 5341, 5343, 5342, 5382 | 3 Credit Hour
