- ◆ The PhD in Nursing program consists of both coursework and research experiences; there are additional costs involved. These additional costs are indicated on the chart below.
- ◆ Prices listed are estimates and based on previous fees and expenses; all pricing and requirements are subject to change. Prices listed are rounded to the nearest \$5.00.
- ◆ For a student pursuing an advanced degree, funding may be limited. For additional information, contact the [UT Arlington Financial Aid Office](#).
- ◆ Due to the rigorous nature of the nursing program and the time commitments of the coursework, it is recommended that students work on a part time basis. Some students may find that is too much, depending on other commitments and personal study habits.
- ◆ UT Arlington offers the [Money Management Center](#) as a resource for assistance with budgeting, savings and credit awareness. Appointments are available in person, over the phone, or via Skype.
- ◆ CONHI Scholarships are available. Apply through [Scholarshop](#).
- ◆ The Nurse Faculty Loan Program (NFLP) is a financial resource with \$35,000 per academic year with an 85% loan forgiveness if graduate assumes a nursing faculty position after graduation.
- ◆ A Registered nurse authorized to practice professional nursing in Texas who would otherwise be required to pay non-Texas resident tuition may be allowed to pay Texas resident tuition rates. Please see the [policy](#) for more information.
