UTA MSAT Application Checklist

Official requirements for entry are in the <u>university catalog</u>. While we make every effort to keep this information accurate, it is provided as a courtesy only for your use as you apply.

Materials Needed for Initial Application:

- UTA MSAT Application for Admission
- Applicant professional resume, including education and relevant experience
- UTA MSAT Clinical Observation Log documenting a minimum of 50 hours of observation with a certified and/or licensed athletic trainer.

*If applicants have additional observation hours, they are encouraged to submit all documentation. *The UTA MSAT will accept other forms of observation hours documentation signed by a certified and/or licensed athletic trainer.*

- Three (3) UTA MSAT Recommendation Forms:
 - One must be completed by the athletic trainer who supervised the applicant's observation hours
 - One must be from a previous instructor or professor who can attest to the applicant's academic performance
 - One may be from a physician, other health care provider, instructor, or employer
- GRE score report (Preferred scores: Verbal 150, Quantitative 141) *UT Arlington graduates who have an undergraduate GPA of 3.0 (or higher) in the last 60 hours as calculated by Graduate Admissions, a 3.0 cumulative GPA, <u>AND</u> a 3.0 in all upper division work are eligible for a GRE waiver (*only applies to UT Arlington graduates*).
- All college/university transcripts (unofficial documents are acceptable). International students must submit front and back copies of transcripts.

Submission

*Submit all materials to <u>msat@uta.edu</u> by November 1st (early admission) or February 1st (regular admission).

Applicants will be notified via email whether or not they have been selected for an interview with the MSAT Admissions Committee. The interview will be conducted in person or virtually.

Following interviews, applicants will be notified via email whether or not they are being extended an invitation to join the UT Arlington MSAT program. If applicants are extended an invitation, they will then be advised to formally apply for graduate admission at UT Arlington and complete their final application materials needed for the MSAT program. These additional materials will include a medical history and physical exam, technical standards for admission – physician version, immunization record, and criminal background check.
