Students on probation, due to a nursing course failure, including pre-nursing courses, pathophysiology or pharmacology are required to take NURS 2232: Professional Nursing and Life Skills course. As a result of the pre-nursing or nursing course failure, student will remain on academic throughout the remainder of nursing school.

Requirements of the course:

- Students must take the course during their next semester.
- Students who are required to take the course, but do not earn a passing grade, will be required to complete the course again and earn a passing grade. Course failure does not count as the second course failure, leading to program dismissal.

Course recommended for the following students:

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- Any student who wishes to improve test taking strategies, time management skills, and clinical skills.
- Students who scored 75% or less in any nursing course are strongly encouraged to enroll in this course.
- Any student who has dropped a nursing course because of potential failure.
