CSE 5393 Directed Study Proposal

CSE 5393 – Directed Study. Topics dealing with special problems in Computer Science on an individual instruction basis.

Directed Study is to be used only in cases where a student's research supervisor determines the need for the course. It is not to be used as a substitute for Thesis I. Each Directed Study course proposal must be approved by a Graduate Advisor, to ensure consistency, *before* the semester registration period begins, and the section should be listed in the available course offerings. Directed Study will not be applied to the degree plan for non-thesis students. Use of Directed Study for other special cases must be approved on a case-by-case basis by the Graduate Advisors.

A syllabus for the course must be provided and should include a list of significant scholarly references. Directed Study is a graded course, so the syllabus should include how the student will be graded.
