Thank you for your interest in our TRIO Pre-College Programs Scholarships!

The information provided below will help you in understanding the scholarship and the guidelines for submitting an application.

In order to apply for one of our scholarships, you must first meet the following qualifications:

- Have been a selected participant in the University of Texas at Arlington Talent Search Program for at least one academic year. (Academic Year is considered Fall and Spring Semesters)
- Be in good standing with the University of Texas at Arlington Talent Search Program and have completed program activities and received services during the current academic year.
- Be a 2022 High School Graduate from one of the University of Texas at Arlington Talent Search Programs.
- Be accepted to attend the University of Texas at Arlington at the time of submission of this scholarship application as a full-time student for the Fall 2022 Class.

If you meet all the above qualifications, please complete the application and submit it on or before May 1, 2022, no later than 5:00 pm (CST).

The following instructions are provided to assist you with the application:

- 1] Complete the TRIO Scholarship Application and submit it by email to talentsearch@uta.edu by the above noted deadline (May 1, 2022).
- 2] Continue with enrolling at The University of Texas at Arlington:
 - A] Attend New Maverick Orientation for Fall Enrollment
 - B] Register for Fall classes
- In August, you will be notified if you are eligible to receive the scholarship and will be require to attend New Scholarship Recipient Orientation.
- 4] New Scholarship Recipient Orientation typically occurs just before Fall classes start. At this orientation, you are required to:
 - A] Sign In on the designated Sign-In Sheet
 - B] Complete all forms given and return them before leaving
- 5] Scholarship funds will be posted to your MyMav account and disbursed within 3-5 weeks of classes beginning.
