Parent/Legal Guardian & Student Please Read:

Students are expected to follow the same rules of conduct and dress code established by your school district and also stated in the Talent Search Program Handbook. The following rules will apply for transportation, lodging and tours:

- No alcohol, drugs, or smoking at any time during the trip.
- No profanity or horse play at any time during the trip.
- Disrespectful behavior toward others, including peers, staff and tour guides, will not be tolerated.
- Students are to always follow the instructions of Talent Search staff members. Staff members should know where students are at all times during the trip. Students should dress to compensate for changes in temperature/weather conditions and wear comfortable walking shoes. Flip-flops and high heels are not allowed on tours.
- Students must be willing to walk during each of the campus tours at a pace equal to the person leading the tour. The tour may take place in inclement weather including intense heat, rain, humidity, etc. and all students must be willing to participate in the walking tour regardless of the weather conditions. In addition, students should be respectful to the tour guide and should be polite in addressing the guide while asking appropriate questions.
- Students may not use cell phones or personal digital equipment during the tour and/or when a tour guide or staff member is speaking. Students are responsible for securing their own personal items.
- Students must travel with photo identification and upon request must present their photo identification to Talent Search staff.
- While in the hotel or other lodging accommodations, students should not:
 - Be outside of their room after "lights out" (curfew).
 - Leave the premises or switch room assignments.
 - Play loud music in their room, disturb guests in any location of the facility or congregate in hallways.
 - Make telephone calls from the hotel room phone. If a student does not have a cell phone and needs to make a call, please speak with a staff member.
 - Remove any items from your hotel room (i.e., pillows, towels, etc.).
 - Vandalize or destroy property in any way.
- Students are ineligible to participate in a Talent Search field trip or college tour until all completed permission forms are on file in the office. All necessary forms should be received in the Talent Search office prior to the student boarding the bus or airplane.
- Students who violate the rules of conduct may be sent home at parent's expense.
