Dear Applicant,

We appreciate your interest in the University of Texas at Arlington Upward Bound Math & Science Center (UBMS). UBMS involves both the year-round Academic Component and Summer Residential Institute. All application materials should be returned to School Counselor or sent to our office by <u>As Specified</u> (priority, first-come first serve). We will process applications as received. Due to limited amount of space availability in our program, <u>earlier submitted completed applications will receive priority attention</u>. Applications submitted after the deadline, will be placed on a waiting list, and reviewed only on an as needed basis.

The selection committee cannot review your application until all forms have been received. The following is a list of what must be included with your completed application:

- 1. One page Autobiography (use paragraph prompts);
- **2.** a copy of your high school transcript (9th grade students exempt);
- **3.** a copy of your last report card (9th grade -use last 8th grade report);
- **4.** a copy of your STAAR and/or PSAT test scores (8th grade or later results);
- 5. a photocopy of your parent's most recent income tax return (2022);
- 6. a photocopy of your Social Security card;
- 7. a copy of your resident card applicable, if you are listed as a permanent resident of the U.S.

- 8. High School counselor (<u>http://bit.ly/AppCounselor</u>) previous counselor acceptable;
- **9.** Math teacher (<u>http://bit.ly/AppTeacher</u>) 9th grade can use previous teacher;
- **10.** Science teacher (<u>http://bit.ly/AppTeacher</u>) 9th grade can use previous teacher;
- 11. TRIO or Gear-Up Director/Advisor (<u>http://bit.ly/AppTRIO</u>) applicable if enrolled.

Optional – Not Required Applicant Items:

- **12.** a copy of birth certificate;
- **13.** a copy of high school or other picture ID.

Your child has chosen to apply to The UT Arlington Upward Bound Math & Science Center because of his/her interest in math or science. UBMS is funded by the U.S. Department of Education and as such has strict guidelines governing selection of participants. Our grant targets 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students from *Cedar Hill* and *DeSoto* areas which are interested in pursuing math, science and/or engineering careers.

We provide year-round college preparatory services and a six-week residential summer program. Participants are given the opportunity to explore careers and technology, work with faculty mentors in rigorous classes, compete in competitions, visit scientific institutions, as well as take educational field trips. A four-year renewable scholarship to UT Arlington is available to participants who successfully complete our program and attend UT Arlington the fall after graduation. In addition, students receive a stipend for full participation in the program throughout the year. All services are funded by the U.S. Department of Education.

In order to further this application process, we need your help. The parent section of the application form plays an important part in our consideration of your child's participation in our program. We cannot stress enough the importance of a completed application, including a photocopy of a signed Federal Income Tax Return Form (*previous year*) or other written verification from the agency that provides you with income (e.g., public assistance, Social Security benefits, unemployment benefits, pensions, etc.). The income verification <u>must</u> list the student as a dependent. The information you provide is protected by the *Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)*; so no one will see the information unless he/she works with or for the Upward Bound Math & Science Center or is specifically authorized to access this information.

- 6. If possible, let someone read and evaluate your draft.
- 7. Type your final draft and print a copy to be included with your UBMS application.
- 8. Your final draft should be only one page single spaced, standard font.

AUTOBIOGRAPHY CONTENTS & OUTLINE:

Answer these topics for each paragraph in your written autobiography.

Paragraph I: <u>Introduce yourself.</u> Tell us about your family. Are you are the oldest, youngest, or somewhere in between? Share how many brothers and sisters, etc. Include information about your place of birth, your family, and/or your home life. Include anything else you feel that's important to know about you.

Paragraph II: <u>Talk about school and academics.</u> Describe some of your experiences, and your achievements in and out of the classroom. Are you satisfied with your current grades? If not, what factors have contributed to your low grades? What are you doing to improve your grades? Do you have any special talents or hobbies? Discuss your extracurricular activities? In what way are you involved in the activity?

Paragraph III: <u>Why College?</u> Discuss your reasons for wanting to go to college. What are your career interests (for example: biology, computer science, engineering, medicine, etc.)? What are some steps you have taken to prepare yourself for college? [You might mention a person who has influenced you to go to college.] Why are you interested in a college education? What other interests do you have?

Paragraph IV: <u>Why UT Arlington UBMS.</u> This is your chance to clearly state why you should be selected to be a participant in UBMS. How will UBMS help you achieve your goals academically, personally or for a future career? Include your ability to participate in the program during the year through graduation.
