- 1. Copy of your high school transcript
- 2. Copy of your last report card / testing results (STAAR/PSAT); 9th submit 8th grade results)
- 3. Photocopy of your parent's most current income tax return (2019 or 2020), *must list the student as the dependent.*
- 4. School record release form
- 5. Photocopy of your Social Security card
- 6. Recommendation from your High School counselor
- 7. Recommendation from your Math teacher
- 8. Recommendation from your Science teacher
- 9. Copy of your resident card if you are listed as a permanent resident of the U.S.

Thank you for taking the time to fill out the forms and gather the needed information to complete this stage of the application process. Students identified as viable candidate will be contacted so an interview can be scheduled. Your child has chosen to apply to The UT Arlington Upward Bound Math & Science Center because of his/her interest in math or science. UBMS is funded by the U.S. Department of Education and as such has strict guidelines governing selection of participants. Our grant targets 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students from the specific schools of *Alvarado*, *Ennis*, *Mansfield Timberview* and *Venus high schools* which are interested in pursuing math, science and/or engineering careers.


We provide year-round college preparatory services and a six-week residential summer program. Participants are given the opportunity to explore careers and technology, work with faculty mentors in rigorous classes, compete in academic/athletic competitions, visit scientific institutions, as well as take educational trips. A four-year renewable scholarship to UT Arlington is available to participants who successfully complete our program and attend UT Arlington the fall year after graduation. All services are funded by the U.S. Department of Education. In addition, students receive a stipend for full participation in the program during the year.

In order to further this application process, we need your help. The parent section of the application form plays an important part in our consideration of your child's participation in our program. We cannot stress enough the importance of a completed application, including a photocopy of a signed Federal Income Tax Return Form or other written verification from the agency that provides you with income (e.g. public assistance, Social Security benefits, unemployment benefits, pensions, etc.). The income verification **must** list the student as a dependent. The information you provide is protected by the *Family Educational Rights Privacy Act (FERPA)*; so no one will see the information unless he/she works with or for the Upward Bound Math & Science program or is specifically authorized to access this information.

Please check with your child to see if he/she needs help in filling out the student portion of the application. All applications should be returned as soon as possible to receive priority attention for program space.

On behalf of the UBMS staff we would like to thank you for taking the time to fill out the application and for supporting your child in obtaining his/her college and career goals.
