

## **RCR Certification Application**

Individuals at UT Arlington are encouraged to participate in RCR activities in addition to the online training and may elect to complete a course of study leading to certification in Responsible Conduct of Research. Participants will be recognized with a certificate and a transcript notation once they have completed the following within two years:

- ► Complete the required General RCR online training module and any other relevant modules https://www.uta.edu/academics/schools-colleges/gradschool/resources/academic/rcr
- ► Attend 3 RCR workshops offered by the RCR Institute. See https://www.uta.edu/academics/schools-colleges/gradschool/resources/workshops-and-programs/rcr for a list of currently offered workshops.
- ▶ Attend 4 other discipline-specific RCR activities. Departments and faculty mentors are expected to provide discipline-specific RCR mentoring to students to fulfill this requirement. Examples of activities that fulfill this requirement include but are not limited to formal or informal courses or class meetings that focus on one or more core areas of RCR training, online training offered by academic units or the Office of Research, informal discussion with a mentor, lab meetings focused on a core area of RCR training, department sponsored events or workshops focused on RCR training.

If you have completed the requirements listed above you are eligible to receive the RCR Certification. Please assemble the following documents and submit to the Office of Graduate Studies, graduate.studies@uta.edu, attn: RCR Certification Program.

- 1. A completed application form. Located online at https://www.uta.edu/academics/schools-colleges/gradschool/resources/academic/rcr
- 2. Online training certificates of completion. The General RCR online training is required for this certification
- 3. Discipline-Specific Activities forms (minimum of four required) https://www.uta.edu/academics/schools-colleges/gradschool/resources/academic/rcr

Applications for RCR certification will be reviewed at the end of each academic semester. Students who qualify for the certification will receive a transcript notation.

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- Complete the online training modules. The General RCR training module is required.
- Attend 3 RCR workshops offered by the RCR Institute
- Attend 4 other RCR activities. Departments and faculty mentors are expected to provide discipline specific RCR mentoring to students to fulfill this requirement. Examples of activities that fulfill this requirement include but are not limited to formal or informal courses or class meetings that focus on one or more core areas of RCR training, online training offered by academic units or the Office of Research, informal discussion with a mentor, lab meetings focused on a core area of RCR training, department sponsored events or workshops focused on RCR training.
