



SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY FUNDING FORM

Purpose: The Honors College is capable of providing funding in support of special academic opportunities with the purpose of enhancing Honors students' undergraduate experiences. These opportunities include but are not limited to research, creative activities, research trips to archives, libraries, or field sites, presentations at professional conferences, and NCHC *Partners in the Park* fees and travel expenses.

Eligibility: Any Honors student in good standing with the College, who is making sufficient progress toward graduating with an Honors degree is eligible to apply for funding.

An eligible application includes a completed Special Opportunity Funding form, a 200-word description of what will be done, including where and when it will happen and how funding will benefit the student academically, and a one-page detailed budget broken down by category. If the student is presenting at a professional conference, they must provide proof of acceptance with their application. To submit a request for special funding, please complete this form and submit it with all other required documentation to honors@uta.edu. If approved, funds will be disbursed to the student's MyMav account.*
