The research proposal needs to include the following sections (use the titles below to differentiate between the sections; do not write the proposal in an essay format):

- Statement of Problem or Research Question (a few sentences) be specific as to whether you are contributing to your faculty mentor's research or if you are researching an independent topic.
- Summary Review of Scholarship Relevant to the Project (a few paragraphs)
- Significance of the Research (a few paragraphs)
- Methodology (a few paragraphs)
- Preliminary Bibliography

Please have your faculty mentor write a letter of recommendation and place it in a sealed and signed envelope.
