

STEPS TO FINANCIAL AID FOR UNDOCUMENTED/DACA STUDENTS



TASFA Application becomes available October 1. Visit www.collegeforalltexas.com to access application.



Here at UTA, TASFA applicants are only eligible for the TEXAS Grant program. Visit www.collegeforalltexas.com for more details.



Submit paper TASFA application to UTFAAO with:
1. Student and Parent tax return transcripts (www.irs.gov).
2. Selective Service Registration Card/Letter if male and at least age 18 (www.sss.gov).



TASFA applicants will be awarded in late Spring.



If awarded, you will be notified via UTA email, informing you to Accept/Decline your financial aid package on your MyMav Student Center.



Submit Senate Bill 1528 Residency Affidavit to UTA Admissions Office (www.uta.edu/admissions).



10 days before courses start each Fall and Spring semester, financial aid will disburse to pay towards tuition and fees.



Submit a final high school transcript to UTA Admissions Office as soon you graduate. If transferring, also submit previous college(s) transcripts.



Renewal requirements for TEXAS Grant Program:
1. First year - meet UTA's Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy (SAP) (www.uta.edu/fao).
2. Second year and beyond - must complete a minimum of 24 credit hours each year and maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.



Priority date is January 15 for incoming freshmen and other first time applicants. You must be admitted by January 15 and submit completed TASFA application to UTFAAO by January 15.



Renew your TASFA application each year beginning October 1.
