

The University of Texas at Arlington is heading west. In August 2024, UTA announced plans to build UTA West, a new campus that will bring all the benefits of a top-tier research university to Fort Worth and Parker County, two of the fastest-growing regions in the country.

UTA West will enable the University to continue its mission of providing greater access to affordable higher education and equipping students with the knowledge they need to thrive. UTA has long been a top supplier of talent to companies and communities across Fort Worth and the region, with top employers of Maverick alumni including Lockheed Martin, Baylor Scott & White Health, Texas Health Resources, Fidelity Investments, and American Airlines. The new campus will bolster this effort by offering a curriculum that supports future economic and workforce development activities in fields that align with the region's growth.

PROJECTED ECONOMIC IMPACT

The initial construction-related activity of UTA West will lead to an increase of **\$211.9 million** in gross product and more than **2,000 jobs** in Texas.

The ongoing economic impact of campus operations and student spending, when fully built out, is projected to be almost **\$292.2 million** in gross product and **2,273 jobs** in Texas.
