Report on the All Encompassing Tuition Review Committee. Collins Watson, chair of the All Encompassing Tuition Review Committee, gave a report on the UT Arlington Tuition Proposal FY2009 and FY2010. Every member institution of the UT System is required to have a tuition review committee. The committee meets every two years to review the tuition structure for the upcoming two years. This committee has been combined with the Fee Oversight Committee this year for the first time. After reviewing the tuition proposal, Watson asked for input from the Undergraduate Assembly.
