Approval of Minutes. The minutes of the regular meeting on November 2, 2010, were approved as published.

Academic Standards Committee. Michael Moore presented the following items for consideration by the Assembly. Each item was presented, discussed and approved separately. Items one through four were unanimously approved. Item five passed with three votes against the proposal.

Academic Standards Committee Report Items for Consideration

1. Social Work – Proposal to increase BSW admission grade point average from 2.0 to 2.5
2. College of Nursing – (a) BSN admission “bump” will be calculated based on 30 hours completed at UT Arlington that apply to the degree, not just any 30 hours; (b) add language related to the HESI A2 exam to the catalog. New language specifies that a remedial math class will be required if applicant scores below a specific cut score.
3. Grade Replacement and Grade Exclusion Policies – clarifies application of policies to courses that may be repeated for credit.
4. Student Grievances Related to Grades – terminates appeal process with the Academic Dean.
5. Add/Drop Policy Changes – terminates the appeal process with the Academic Dean.
