We need to make sure that all department websites are linked to the catalogue and take students there easily, with few clicks. We want to make sure that all information should appear in the catalogue. Dr. Aswath will be calling on members for a committee to be looking at the level of consistency and availability, as the catalogue is important for the recruitment and transparency for students. Volunteers are welcome to contact Dr. Aswath.

Dr. Cole commented that UTA's search engine is not good and that she often has to go through Google instead. Dr. Aswath replied that they are looking into fixing this issue.

New Academic Program Proposal Process

Dr. Amber Smallwood presented a new form that will aid in streamlining the proposal process for degrees, certificates and minors. The idea is that the form will be more inclusive so that all the information needed as it moves up the chain will be there, rather than having the proposals being kicked back for information that is lacking. All the information could be copied and pasted into the documents for Coordinating Board. She shared the document in the chat section of Teams, so the UA could see it.

Dr. Smallwood then shared a workflow chart for the proposal stages, also in the chat section of Teams. There is a simplified version of it online.
