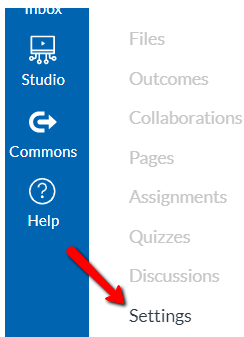
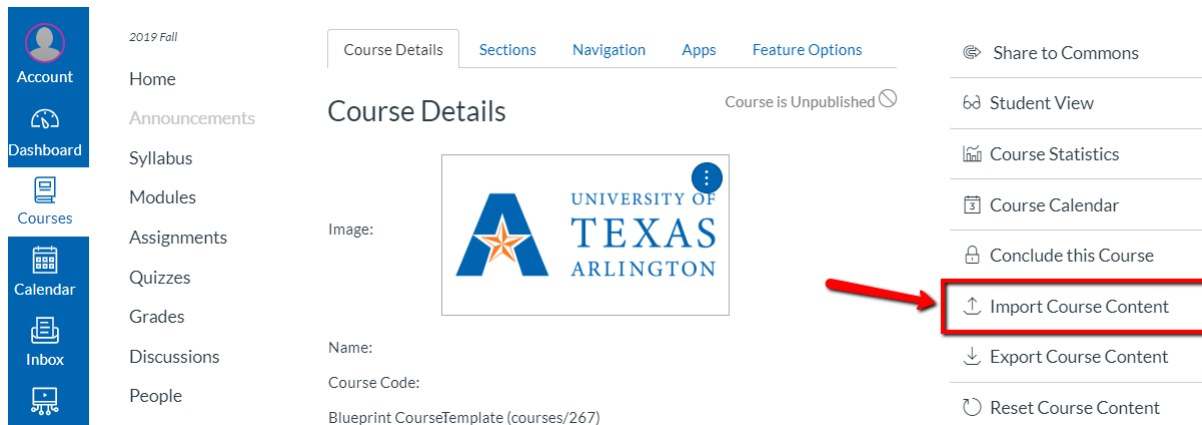


# Import Blackboard Course to Canvas

Go to your Course in Canvas and click on **Settings** in the course menu.

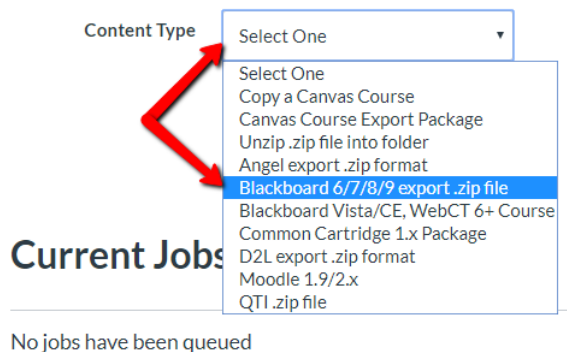


From the **Settings** page, click on the **Import Course Content** link in the menu on the right side of the page. *If the menu does not appear on the right side of the page, scroll down. The menu may have been moved to accommodate the size of your browser window.*



On the Import Content page, click on the drop-down menu labeled **Content Type** and select **Blackboard 6/7/8/9 export .zip file**.

## Import Content



- 1) In the **Source** area, click on **Choose File** and select the Blackboard export file (.zip) from your computer.
- 2) In the **Content** area, select **All content**.
- 3) Click on the **Import** button



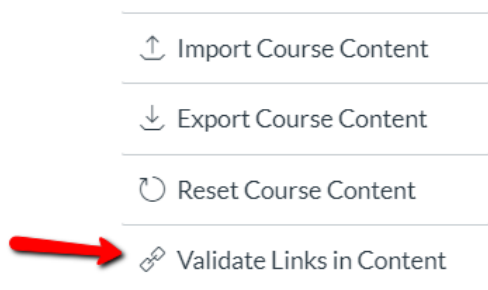

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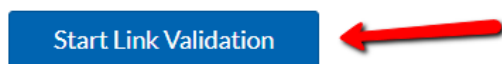
